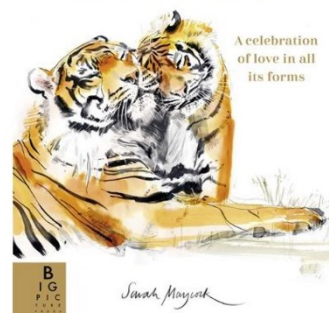


WORLD BOOK DAY

Reading is quiet like a mouse but sometimes it is loud. Reading is fun like a cat and playful like a dog. - Millie M, Year 2

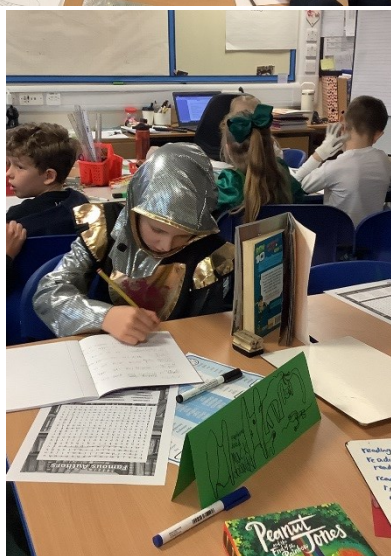


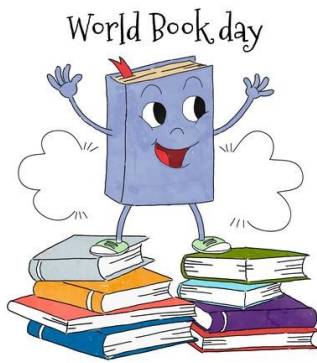
Key Stage 2 produced some lovely watercolour animals from the book 'Love is...'. They finished the sentence starter 'Love Is' with their own words too.

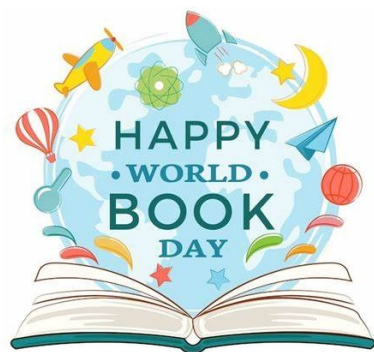

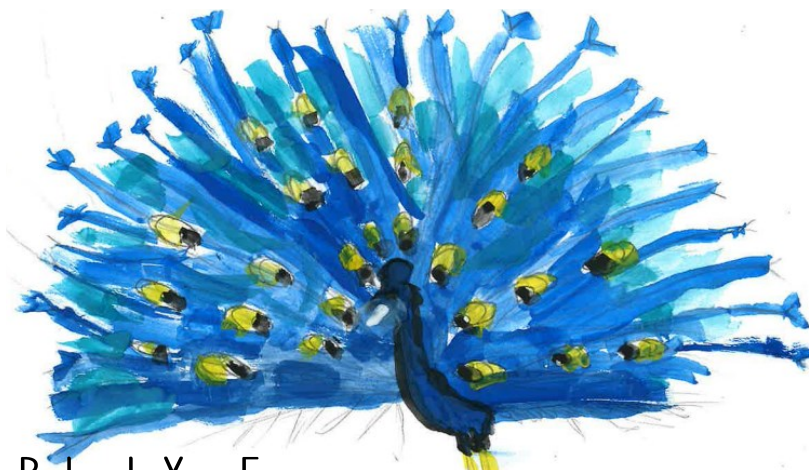

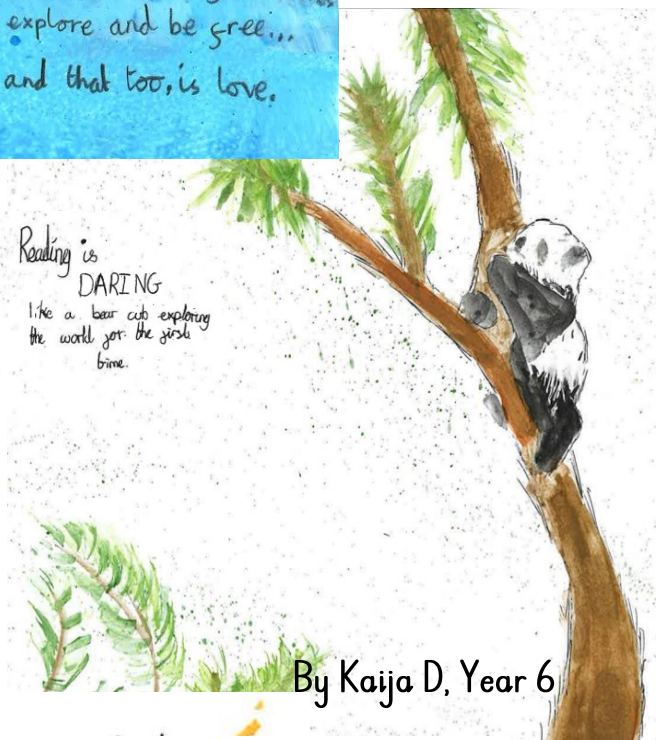
