## The School's Dress Code

Please can we remind all parents of the school's dress code.

We always encourage the wearing of smart school uniform.

However, we are very conscious as a school that branded uniform costs are high and as such, we do not insist that the children wear clothing with the school logo. Most supermarkets sell the coloured uniform at much lower prices. As long as their uniform is in school colours this will be fine.

### Our school uniform is:

**Girls** - Navy blue school sweatshirt or cardigan, white or blue polo shirt, black, navy blue or grey skirt, pinafore or trousers.

**Boys** - Navy blue school sweatshirt, white or blue polo shirt, grey or black trousers.

**All children must wear black SMART shoes.**

### For PE lessons pupils need:

Plain white or blue t-shirt, plain black or blue shorts or jogging bottoms, plimsolls and a pair of trainers for outdoor lessons.

As above, the PE kit can also be ordered through Brigade.

Children must not wear any jewellery, including earrings for PE. Hair must also be tied back.

Branded sportswear of any kind is not permitted.

We would also ask that children do not wear hoodies to school, even in Brixworth colours.


