Arrival Information

Please enter the school via the main school gate on Froxhill Crescent (not the office) between 5.40-5.45pm. Children **MUST** arrive on time.

Year 5 & 6 children will go in through the Year 5 & 6 entrance.

Year 3 & 4 children will go in via the entrance to the top of the ramp.

Staff will be on hand to direct.

Parents will then progress to the school playground.

Children will be seated in a designated area on the playground in their class groups.

We will be selling warm winter spice alcohol free drinks and mince pies. 50p each or £1 for both.

We will only be able to accept CASH.

Once the carol concert has finished your child will return with their teacher to their classroom.

Departing Information

All pupils **MUST** be collected as no pupil will be allowed to walk home alone.

Please see below for collection arrangements for your child:

Year 5 & 6

The year 5 classes are to be collected from their usual collection points.
